Getting to the Exhibition

The exhibition is located at the Ngee Ann Kongsi Concourse Gallery, Level B1.

From Coleman Street Entrance: Proceed to Lift Lobby A and take the accessible lift to Level B1. From Lift Lobby A, proceed down the corridor towards the Ngee Ann Kongsi Concourse Gallery.

Nearest Lift Lobby: If you are coming from elsewhere in the Gallery, the nearest lift lobby to the Ngee Ann Kongsi Concourse Gallery is Lift Lobby B.

Entrance and Exit: There is step-free access to the Ngee Ann Kongsi Concourse Gallery. However, please note that you will need to open a manual swing door to access the exhibition gallery. If necessary, there are staff nearby who can provide assistance.

Accessible Toilets: The nearest accessible toilet is located opposite Lift Lobby B. Please note that this accessible toilet has a manual swing door.

Drinking Fountains & Baby Changing Rooms: Drinking fountains and baby changing rooms are located near Lift Lobby A.

General Exhibition Accessibility

Wheelchair Accessibility: The exhibition is wheelchair-accessible.

Seating: Limited seating is available throughout the exhibition at the reading table and TV viewing area. Please note that these seats have no armrests and backrests.

Lighting: The exhibition space is well-lit.

Exhibition Content:

- Exhibition texts are available in Malay, Tamil and Chinese as digital room sheets, which can be accessed via the QR code at the entrance of the exhibition.
- English subtitles are available for videos shown in the exhibition, except for *Home Service*.

Protruding Objects: Please note that part of the artwork installation for *Home Service* protrudes from the wall. It has been demarcated by a black tape on the floor, please be mindful of your step.

Gallery hosts are stationed throughout the exhibition for any additional support you may require.
