Getting to the Exhibition

The exhibition is located along the Spine Hall on Level B1.

From Coleman Street Entrance: Proceed to Lift Lobby A and take the accessible lift to Level B1. From Lift Lobby A, proceed down the corridor towards the Spine Hall.

Nearest Lift Lobby: If you are coming from elsewhere in the Gallery, the nearest lift lobbies are Lift Lobby B and D.

Entrance and Exit: There is step-free access to the Spine Hall.

Accessible Toilets: The nearest accessible toilet is located opposite Lift Lobby B. Please note that this accessible toilet has a manual swing door.

Drinking Fountains & Baby Changing Rooms: Drinking fountains are located near Lift Lobbies A and B. Baby changing rooms are located near Lift Lobby A.

General Exhibition Accessibility

Wheelchair Accessibility: The exhibition is wheelchair-accessible.

Flooring: The flooring is carpeted and there are raised trunkings for cables highlighted with warning tape. Please mind your step.

Seating: Seating is not available in the exhibition. The nearest seating area is located at Padang Atrium.

Lighting: The exhibition space is well-lit.

Exhibition Content: Exhibition texts are available in English.
