Getting to the Artwork

This artwork is located at the City Hall Wing, Level 5, Ng Teng Fong Roof Garden Gallery.

From Coleman Street Entrance: Proceed to Lift Lobby A and take the accessible lift to Level 5. Please note that you will need to open a heavy manual glass door to access the roof garden. The artwork is in the middle of the garden on an elevated platform.

Nearest Lift Lobby: If you are coming from elsewhere in the Gallery, the nearest lift lobby to the Ng Teng Fong Roof Garden Gallery is Lift Lobby B.

Entrance and Exit: Please note that the artwork is displayed on an elevated platform. You will need to either climb a flight of steps or use the ramp to access the gallery.

Accessible Toilets: The nearest accessible toilets are located near Lift Lobbies A and B in the City Hall Wing. Please note that you will need to open a heavy manual glass door to get to the accessible toilets.

Drinking Fountains & Baby Changing Rooms: Drinking fountains and baby changing rooms are located near Lift Lobbies A and B.

General Space Accessibility

Warning: The artwork features a steel structure painted in neon orange which may cause visual discomfort to some. Please exercise caution if you are sensitive to bright colours.

Wheelchair Accessibility: The space is wheelchair-accessible.

Shelter: Please note that the artwork is in an open-air area and is not sheltered.

Seating: Floor mats are available for loan if you wish to sit on the floor and experience the artwork. The nearest public seating area is located near lift lobbies A and B.

Hanging Objects: The artwork features metal discs, chimes and bells suspended from a painted steel structure. Please watch your step and be mindful of the hanging elements.

Tactile experiences: Visitors are welcome to touch and interact with the hanging objects and steel structures.

Exhibition Content: The artwork label is only available in English.

Gallery hosts are stationed throughout the Gallery for any additional support you may require.
