National Gallery Singapore is a visual arts institution which oversees the largest public collection of modern art in Singapore and Southeast Asia. Situated in the heart of the Civic District, the Gallery is housed in two national monuments—City Hall and former Supreme Court—that have been beautifully restored and transformed into this exciting venue.

Reflecting Singapore’s unique heritage and geographical location, the Gallery features Singapore and Southeast Asian art from Singapore’s National Collection in its long-term and special exhibitions. The Gallery also works with international museums to jointly present Southeast Asian art in the global context, positioning Singapore as a regional and international hub for the visual arts.

In 2016, the Gallery won the awards for “Best Attraction Experience”, “Breakthrough Contribution to Tourism” and “Best Customer Service (Attractions)” at the prestigious Singapore Tourism Awards for its role in adding to the vibrancy of Singapore’s tourism landscape.

Gallery Security Officer

This role aspires towards supporting the national effort to tell inspiring stories, create curiosity and a moving experience for all visitors. The principal responsibility is to ensure the safety and security of the national and world heritage treasures on site, its occupants and as well as its employees.

RESPONSIBILITIES

- Monitor security systems installed in the gallery
- Perform access control procedures within the premises
- Provide first response capability in emergency situations
- Ensure appropriate interaction (polite but firm) with visitors, contractors and employees as the standard communication with them
- Maintain vigilance and security presence to deter disorderly and threatening behaviour
- Maintain crowd control

REQUIREMENTS

- A professional security officer's license issued by the PLRD
- Relevant experience in a hospitality or tourism industry is preferred
- Fluent in spoken and written English
- IT literate
- Physically fit
- Able to work independently and as part of a team
- Good interpersonal and communication skills
